Responsibilities of the OCR

per VI Code 19 VIC §777e

Introduction to Draft Proposed Rules & Regulations Town Hall 28 February 2022 | VI CAB/OCR

"The Director of the OCR has the responsibility to ensure:

- (1) the ability of qualifying patients in all areas of the Territory to obtain timely access to high-quality medical cannabis;
- (2) the effectiveness of the dispensaries and cultivation facilities, individually and together, in serving the needs of qualifying patients, including the provision of educational and support services by dispensaries, the reasonableness of their prices, whether they are generating any complaints or security problems, and the sufficiency of the number operating to serve the Territory's registered qualifying patients;
- (3) the effectiveness of the cannabis testing facilities;
- (4) the sufficiency of the regulatory and security safeguards contained in this chapter and adopted by the OCR to ensure that access to and use of cannabis cultivated is provided only to cardholders;
- (5) the proposal of additions or revisions to the OCR regulations or this chapter, including relating to security, safe handling, labeling and nomenclature; and
- (6) that research studies regarding health effects of medical cannabis for patients are encouraged and conducted."



- Receipt of Approval for Legal Sufficiency
 - +/- 5 Days CAB Board Meeting to Approve Proposed Rules & Regulations
 - Press Release Notifying Public on Availability
- Rules & Regulations Posted for Public Comment on OCR Website
 - 30 Day Comment Period
- +/- 5 Days Summary of Comments Composed
- +/- 5 Days CAB Board Meeting to Approve Final Rules & Regulations
- +/- 10 Days OCR to roll out initial applications on a bi-weekly basis; schedule forthcoming
 - ~ 55 Days to applications upon receipt of the approved document


Application Information


- OCR is not currently accepting registrations or applications of any kind.
